A continuation of the Public Hearing initially held on November 17, 2015 is scheduled for Wednesday, January 20, 2016 at 8:30 A.M. in the Lipan-Kickapoo Water Conservation District Office, Suite C, Vancourt Post Office Building, Vancourt, Texas. The purpose of this hearing is to take public comment on a Permit Application and Draft Permit to Transport Water from the District by the City of Winters.

Location of Wells:

North Tract - 78.936 acres out of Section #325, Block 64, H & TC
Ry. Co Survey, Runnels County, Texas.
South Tract - 40.159 acres out of Section #327, Block 64, H & TC
Ry. Co Survey, Runnels County, Texas.

Proposed Well Use:

Provide treated water to both the residents of the City of Winters and to the North Runnels Water Supply Corporation.

Amount of Water to be Transported Monthly:

2.25 Million gallons (7 acre feet) per month

Description of Transportation Facility:

A total of four wells are proposed to be connected by underground lines to a ground storage tank to be located east of Antelope Creek on the north side of FM 1770. This tank will be connected by a proposed raw water line west along FM 1770 to CR 170 and then south along CR 170 to connect to the existing raw water line that connects Lake Winters to the City of Winters water treatment plant.

Anyone wishing to provide oral or written testimony or evidence either in support of or against the approval of this request may appear and be heard at the hearing. *
