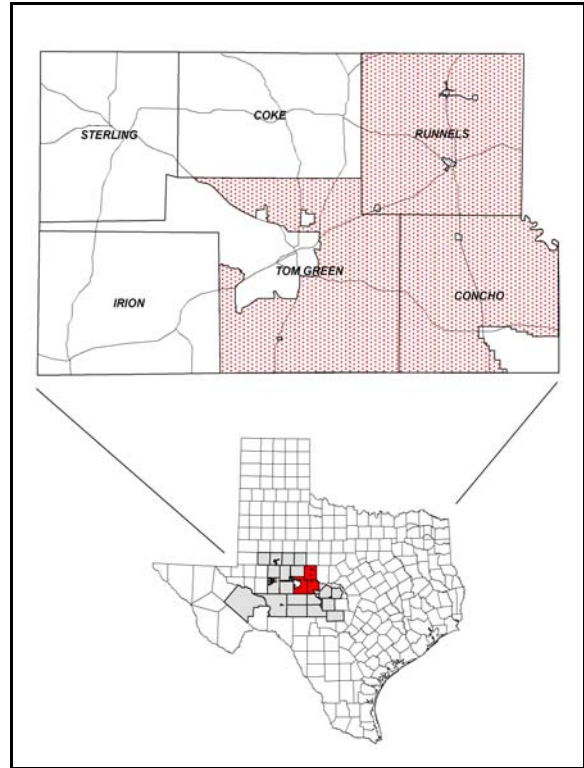

SIZE: 2,262,464 acres (3,535 sq. mi.)

AQUIFER: Lipan Minor Aquifer and Edwards-Trinity Aquifer.

WATER USAGE: Mostly agricultural and domestic, some municipal and industrial.

Average water table: 35' below land surface (Table varies from 0' to 120' plus).
