### Water Levels and Rainfall

**A**nother year is coming to an end and in terms of rainfall and water levels, it has been a good one. I will be downloading the remainder of the rainfall data beginning next week and will then be able to total up each rain station for 2016. Although I do not have final totals, most areas have received more than thirty inches of rainfall for the year! Thirty inches is a wonderful number, being that our annual average is around twenty two inches. Needless to say, we are heading into the new year with very favorable water levels. Last week I measured the monthly water levels for December and was not too surprised by the results. Most wells are still seeing increasing water levels, while a handful of others are marginally down due to equilibration. We have a chance of some icy precipitation on January 5<sup>th</sup>, but that seems to be the only precipitation forecasted for the first few weeks of the new year. Next month, I will be graphing the water levels for 2016, so if we monitor your well, you will be receiving your annual graph shortly. If we are not monitoring your wells, you can find levels posted on the website. We at the
