Farmers this year have lots of wheat planted and it is needing all the water they can pump due to there being almost no spring rains so far this year. In some of the heavier irrigation areas levels were down 5 feet to 20 feet.

Historically we are not far from what waters levels were the last two years for this month. We are up from levels last year, but down from levels two years ago.
